Thank you for your kind participation in the 38<sup>th</sup> International Doubles Tournament. Please read the text below for the rules and guidelines for this tournament.

### **General Information**

- Please be careful with your valuables. YITC cannot accept responsibility for lost or stolen articles. Please place your baggage on the green plastic sheets adjacent to the clubhouse. Baggage placed in the clubhouse will be moved to the green plastic sheets.
- Olympic abbreviations are used for the country names.
- Coupons are provided for each player. Please redeem your coupons which is on the back page of the program within the designated time.

## **Tournament Rules**

### **Choice of Side and Service**

- The choice of Side and the right to be Server or Receiver in the first game shall be decided by racquet toss. The players winning the toss may choose, or require their opponents to choose.
  - (a) The right to be Server or Receiver, in which case the other players shall choose their preferred Side.
  - (b) The Side, in which case the other players shall choose the right to be Server or Receiver.

### **Foot Fault**

- The Server shall throughout the delivery of the service:
  - Not touch, with either foot, any area other than that behind the base-line within the imaginary extension of the center mark and side-lines.

### **Ball Touches Permanent Fixtures**

- If the ball in play touches a permanent fixture other than the net post, cord or metal cable, strap or band after it has hit the ground, the players who struck it win the point.
- If before it hits the ground, their opponents win the point.

## **Other Match Information**

- Dunlop balls are used as official balls.
- Court surface is clay.
- Warm-up time allowed before the start of your first match is 3 minutes and 4 practice Serves from the second match.
- Please refrain from practicing against the wall.
- A maximum of 5 minutes is allowed for rest in case of cramps, sudden pain, injury, etc.
- With the exception of the finals, the tournament format is a 6-game match: tie-break (first to 7 points, margin of 2) at 6-6.
- The format for the finals is 8-game pro-set match: tie-break (first to 7 points, margin of 2) at 8-8.
- All matches are to be conducted by the self-judge method.
- All players are treated equally.
- Players must follow the JTA TENNIS RULE BOOK 2026.
- Format and schedule are subject to change due to weather and other conditions.

### **Information between matches**

- The announcers at the referee desk will call your name for only first round 6 matches.
- There will be less announcement thereafter, so please pay attention to the 'Order of Play' on the whiteboard at the referee desk where following matches will be displayed.
- Designated pairs should come to the referee desk when the names appear on the whiteboard. Balls and score sheet will be provided.
- Please stand by at the designated court and start the match soon after the previous match end.
- At the end of the match, confirm the result with the roving umpire and return the game balls to the umpire.
- Only after the first-round match, not only the winner but also the loser are requested to come to the referee desk, where the winner will be given the information regarding the 2<sup>nd</sup> round and the loser will be given the information regarding the consolation match.

### **Consolation Match Format**

Teams that do not win their first-round match will automatically be entered in the Consolation round. Due to time constraints, please understand the following rules for Consolation round matches.

- In the Consolation rounds, the winner is the first team to win 6 games.
- At 5-5, there will be one last game to decide the winner (no tie-break).
- The no-add system will be used. At deuce, the Receiving team can choose the serving side for Men's Doubles, and for Mixed Doubles, the Receiver should be the same gender as the Server.

### **Injury During Match Play**

As mentioned in the "Other Match Information" section, a maximum of 5 minutes is allowed for rest in case of cramps, sudden pain, injury, etc. In case of injury, a licensed physician is available for consultation and first-aid care. YITC has taken out standard accident insurance for such instances. Please note that the accident insurance shall be applicable within the range of the insurance policy only if the player announces his / her injury during the game to a referee or roving umpire of YITC on the day of the 38<sup>th</sup> International Doubles Tournament, and the referee or roving umpire recognizes the injury. Otherwise, the accident insurance is not applicable to the injury. This section "Injury During Match Play" indemnifies and holds YITC harmless from the accident liability exceeding the range of the insurance, as well as from the first-aid care.

### **Tournament Postponement and Cancellation**

If games cannot be played on Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup> due to bad weather, games will be played on the backup day, Sunday May 17<sup>th</sup>.

If the weather conditions are questionable on May 16<sup>th</sup>, players are kindly requested to come to YITC "In Pairs" by the time designated on the official draw. If the pair is not present by the time of play, the match will be considered as defaulted by the missing pair.

Depending on the weather conditions, the tournament referee will make a preliminary decision at 7am on May 16<sup>th</sup>, whether to suspend the tournament or to postpone it to May 17<sup>th</sup>. A final decision that differs from the preliminary decision may be made no later than 10am. The preliminary and final decision will be announced at the club and will be posted on the YITC Home page – <https://www.yitc.org>, as well as the YITC Facebook page – <https://www.facebook.com/1878yitc/>. Please refrain from calling the YITC office to confirm the tournament cancellation.

If the referee decides to hold the tournament on the backup day May 17<sup>th</sup>, players are requested to come to YITC by the designated time to play. If the weather conditions are also questionable on the backup day, announcements will be made at the club, on the YITC home page, and on the YITC Facebook as specified above.

If the tournament cannot be played on the backup day, the 2026 YITC International Doubles Tournament will be canceled, and Entry fees will be refunded. Entry fees will only be refunded as cash at the YITC office until Sunday May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

### **Best Dresser Prize**

In addition to prizes awarded to the winners and runners-up, YITC will award Best Dresser Prizes to Men's and Mixed Doubles. Please come play in your best creative tennis outfits.
